


MacArthur's "direct" CEA grantmaking program:

- Expands focus on racial equity
- Uses a participatory process to make funding recommendations
- No longer bases grant award amounts on the size of the grantee organization's annual budget size

MacArthur and Field are committed to fostering equity and will continue to support small and mid-sized arts organizations.

The ART program with Field will be a multimillion-dollar investment in Chicago's arts and culture sector made by MacArthur as part of its Culture, Equity, and the Arts program.

- MacArthur will continue to support small and mid-sized arts and culture organizations with multi-year unrestricted funding.
- Field will regrant MacArthur funds through the ART program to organizations with budgets of less than \$1 million.


